

POINTS TO REMEMBER FOR VIRTUAL GATHERINGS.

In order to speed up the process of a Virtual Gathering Please take note of the following.

1. How to record your video:

Recording done on a regular Cowboy Dressage 20/40 court.

- <u>The person taking the video must please announce the rider, the horse and the test.</u> We cannot hear when the rider announces themselves.
- To film, you will set your camera behind the letter C (where the judge normally will be seated) make sure you have all the corners visible;
- Set your camera horizontally;
- Be sure to get the **full picture** of the horse in the corners –Y-M and Q-H;
- Zoom in when the rider is at "A", and zoom out when the rider approaches "A" coming towards "C". Do not zoom in too much the horse must be visible relative to his position in the arena.
- Keep the camera as still as possible and do not "follow" the horse. Rather zoom out.
- Please adhere to the Cowboy Dressage rules relating to dress code and tack.
- Do not add music to non- Freestyle tests.
- The clearer the video, the easier it is to judge.
- 2. Every video should be <u>labeled before submission</u>. We often receive a video of a horse and rider and we have no idea who this is, and what test they are doing. We need the name of the Rider, the name of the horse, and the test.
- 3. Only videos submitted to "www.wetransfer.com will be accepted.
- 4. When sending your Proof of Payment via e-mail, please use your register number as reference.
